BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 1036 amends the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Article 3 to Chapter 15, Title 40 so as to enact the "Dental Sedation Act", to provide requirements concerning the provision of varying levels of sedation to dental patients. The Bill also amends Section 40-15-85, relating to definitions in the Dentistry Practice Act, so as to add necessary definitions; and to designate the existing Sections of Chapter 15, Title 40 as Article 1 "General Provisions".

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:

The Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation estimates this Bill will have no fiscal impact on the State General Fund or on Federal and/or Other Funds.
