BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 1056 amends Section 40-25-60, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the license required to engage in the practice of specializing in hearing aids. The Bill provides that no person may engage in the practice of specializing in hearing aids or display a sign or in another way advertise or represent himself as a person who engages in the practice unless he holds an unsuspended, unrevoked license issued by the Department.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:
