BILL SUMMARY:

The Bill would amend the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, by adding Section 59-26-45, so as to provide that the Principal or School District must notify parents if their children are being taught by an annual contract teacher undergoing a highly consequential evaluation or a continuing contract teacher who has received written notification is undergoing a formal summative evaluation.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:
