BILL SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 1163 amends Sections 63-7-840 and 63-7-1990 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as they relate to the use of unfounded abuse and neglect case information and the confidentiality and release of information concerning the central child abuse and neglect registry, by allowing the Director or their Designee to release information to confirm, clarify or correct information concerning a case that has been made public by sources other than the Department.
