### **BILL SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 1172 amends Title 60, Chapter 15 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976 by adding a section requiring the South Carolina Arts Commission to develop criteria and guidelines for designating a cultural district by the State. The Bill provides a definition of cultural districts and specifies duties and responsibilities of the Commission related to these districts.
