## **Local Revenue**

This bill amends Section 4-10-470 so that a county that does not meet the \$7 million minimum state accommodations sales and use tax collection requirement of 4-10-470(A) may impose a local educational capital improvement tax if the county had not imposed the tax for twenty years or more as of the date in the imposition of the education capital improvements sales tax authorized in this article was first proposed in that county in a 2014 referendum. There would be no revenue impact to the General Fund, Federal Funds, Other Funds, or local governments in FY 2016-17 and each year thereafter.
